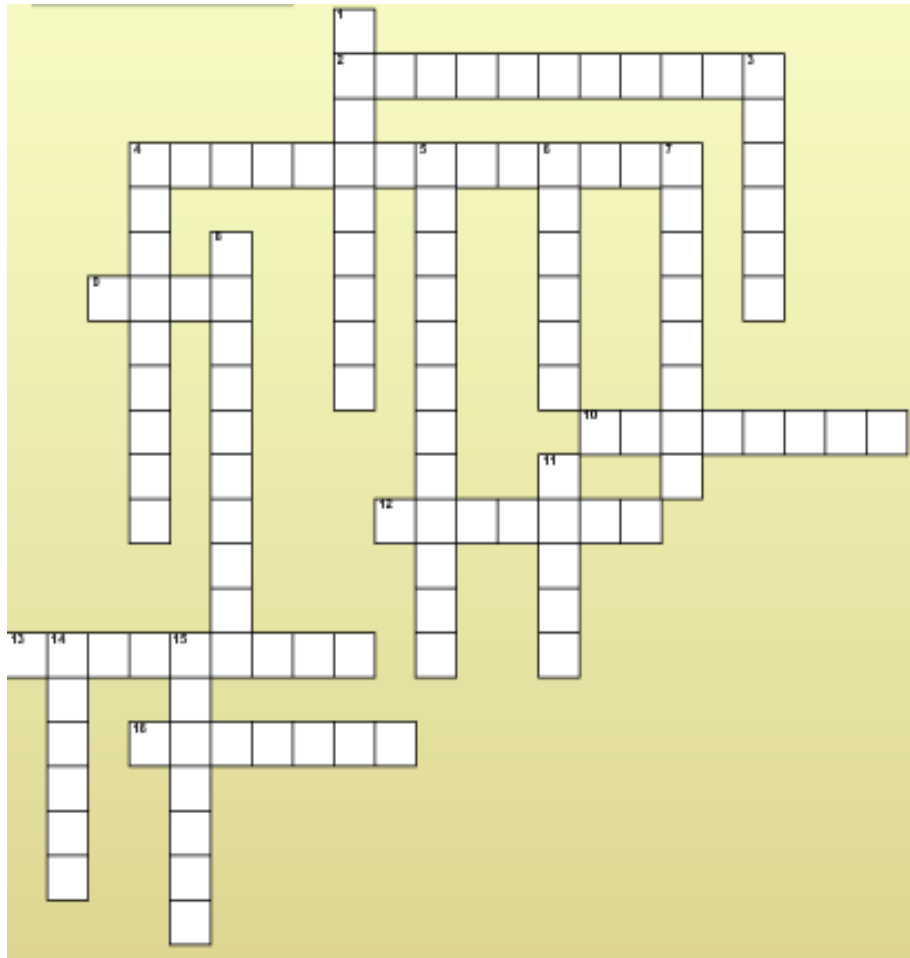

ACROSS:

- 2. Never a skilled service. Word not to be used. 0 minutes billing.
- 4. Required by the therapist to bill treatment time.
- 9. Not necessarily a skilled activity. Why couldn't the patient use this on their own? Must include skill.
- 10. Need a related goal to bill time for this activity dealing with wheelchairs or bed.
- 12. Sounds unskilled if what patient is doing. Use skilled verbs.
- 13. Must differentiate eval time from treatment time in notes.
- 16. Encouragement without participation is still 0 billing.

DOWN:

- 1. Not a skilled service, but a nursing activity. 0 billing.
- 3. Not necessarily a skilled activity. Why couldn't the patient use this on their own? Must include skill.
- 4. Must include ROM/skin check/tolerance in notes.
- 5. Needed in ALL treatment notes to show skill.
- 6. Should be included with most patients' notes.
- 7. Needs skilled details, not just repetition of same ones.
- 8. If over and over, how is it a skilled service?
- 11. Treatment notes should include these related areas.
- 14. Sounds like unskilled labor, not skilled therapy. Use skilled verbs instead.
- 15. To bill, need a related goal and not just watching a patient eat.
